Introduction

Pattern of examination and its efficacy determines the diagnostic and terminal behaviour of the students. Hence the need to make it fit to stand the test of time becomes pertinent. Educationists, policymakers, teachers need to put their endeavour towards revamping the examination system and prepare a model ensuring validity, reliability and objectivity in the examination system and help making all round development of a student possible. The deficiencies in the system need revamping with the objective to raise not only the knowledge and skills of the students but also the quality of education imparted in the institutions of higher learning.

The present workshop is an endeavour to bring Registrars/Deputy Registrars/Controllers of Examinations, Deputy/Assistant Controllers of Examinations, Senior University Officers and Academics to a common platform to review the current scenario with reference to examination patterns and their deficiencies both in academic and administrative issues. The deliberations at the workshop will focus on the issues related to present examination system, and suggestions for its improvement to make it adaptable to the present global scenario.
